Cost of living and earnings

Cost of living

- Higher compared to other European countries
- Large cities vs mid-sized cities
- Amsterdam, Rotterdam vs Eindhoven, Maastricht

Earnings

- Higher compared to other European countries
- Netherlands **ranked 4th** average annual wages in Europe, after Iceland, Luxemburg and Switzerland (statista.com)

Costs of living are higher, however earnings are also higher.
