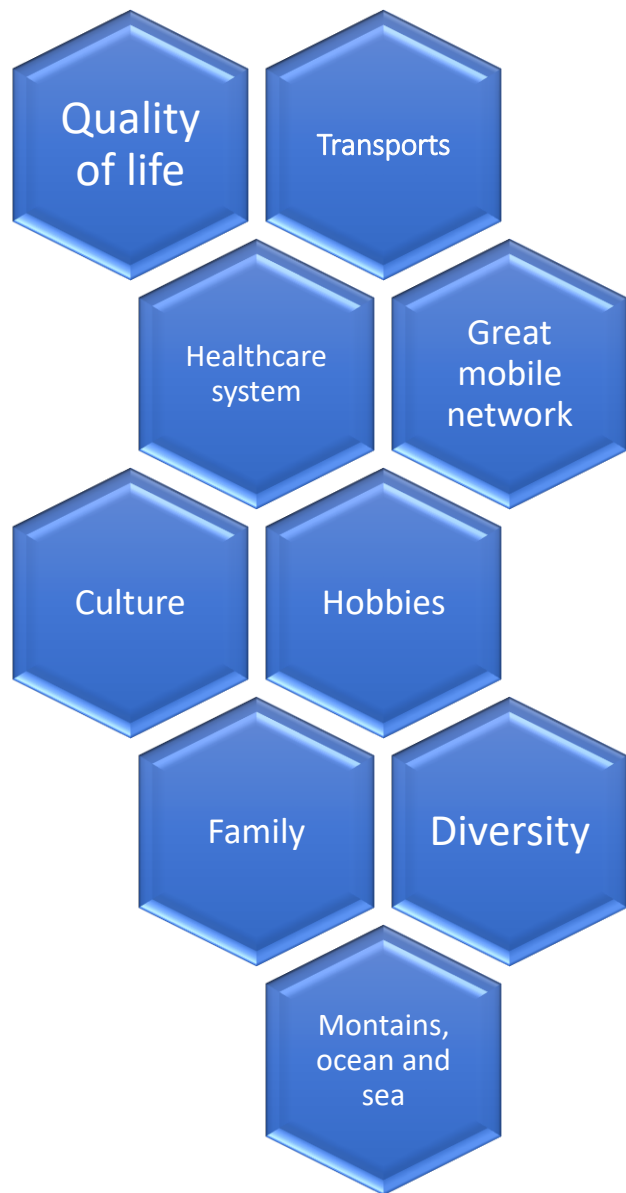

Contracts

Main types of contracts

CDI : permanent contracts

CDD :fixed-term contracts for a specific duration (max 18 months)

Temping contract : same as CDD with 3 parties involved : employer, employee & temping agency

Other types of contracts

Seasonal:in agriculture and tourism

Apprenticeship:part time in a training, and the rest of the time working

Intermittent : specific short-term contract for artists or technicians
